MEMORANDUM

The undersigned Ministry offers to Mr. Santosh Kumar Dnyaneshwar Son of Shri. Dnyaneshwar Nagji Adukar a post of Constable (General Duty) on my minimum pay of Rs. 21,000/- only in the Title Name (D.E.O.-3) in Sashastra Seema Bal. He will also be entitled to draw other allowances, at the rates or amounts to Central Govt. employees, subject to the conditions as laid down in the rules and orders governing the grant of such allowances in the post from time to time.

Please see the conditions of appointment as per below:

a. On joining the Force, he/she will be governed by the Sashastra Seema Bal Act 2007 & Rules 2009, manuals & other rules orders as issued and amended from time to time by the Government.

b. The appointment is purely temporary but likely to continue. He/she will act on probation for a period of 03 (Three) years from the date of appointment. The competent authority as constituted under SSB Rules may, for the reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation for such further period as may not exceeding two years or may during the period of probation, terminate his services without assigning reasons. His/her permanent appointment to the post, however, will depend upon various factors governing terms of permanent appointment to such posts in force at that time.

c. His/her services on joining temporary Government service shall be liable to termination at any time by a notice in writing given either by him to the appointing authority or by the appointing authority to him. The period of notice shall be one month; provided that the services may be terminated forthwith with or such amount of pay which shall be entitled to him a sum equivalent to the amount of pay plus allowances to the period of notice at the same rates as which he/she was drawing, than immediately before the termination of his/her services or as the case may be, for the period by which such notice falls short of one month.

d. The competent authority as prescribed under SSB Rules may, having regard to the special circumstances of any case, permit him/her to resign from the force before completing the term of the engagement provided that while granting such permission, the competent authority as prescribed may require him/her to return to the Government such amount as would constitute the cost of training given to him/her or three months' pay and allowances whichever is higher. Provided further that he/she on tendering resignation, for accepting a post under the Central or State Government and local bodies, after having been granted cadre clearance for the same or who has completed ten years of service shall not be required to return the sum as provided hereinafter.

e. On appointment he/she shall be liable to serve in any part of India as well as outside India.

f. He/she will be governed by the New Community Person Scheme for generosity benefit effective from 01/01/2024.

g. He/she will have to qualify 'Basic Recruit Training Course' being conducted by Sashastra Seema Bal within a period of two years from the date of appointment. No more than two chances will be given to qualifying Basic Recruit Training Course taking which teacher services shall be liable to him/her.

h. He/she will have to undergo various training courses as may be prescribed, from time to time.

i. He/she will not be entitled to any Training Allowance/Dearness Allowance for joining on his/her first appointment.

j. He/she should bring a Certificate from the local administrative authority like Class Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate / Tehsildar, or any Officer superior to them in the State/Central Government, regarding his/her character and antecedents (as per format enclosed), which should have not been issued before six months of date of joining.

k. The verification of Character and Antecedents would be carried out immediately on joining from the concerned District Administration. In the event of furnishing false or misleading information at the time of appointment in the service, neither anybody is liable to be terminated as per the provisions of SSB Act and Rules. Moreover, if any facts or statement mentioned by the candidate in the application form being false or incorrect or any adverse finding is reported against him or her, the individual is also liable for disciplinary action under the provisions of SSB Act and Rules.

l. If anyone has been selected against his/herancy in General category, The appointment is provisional and is subject to verification of Schedule Caste/Other Backward Classes/OBC Certificate (if applicable). If the verification reveals that the claim bearing to Scheduled Castes/Schedules, Tribe or OBC, as the case may be, is found false, his/her services will be terminated forthwith without assigning any further reasons or without proceeding to such further action as may be taken under the provisions of the SSB Act 2007 / Indian Penal Code for production of false certificate.

m. For Other Backward Classes candidates the Community Certificate should invariably be issued by the designated authority only. If an verification is revealed that his/her claim of belonging to Other Backward Classes and not belonging to creamy Layer is false, his/her services will be terminated forthwith without assigning any further reasons or without proceeding to such further action as may be taken under the provisions of SSB Act 2007/Indian Penal Code for production of false certificate.

n. He/she should bring Verification Bill form (prescribed) containing signature with seal on the 'Identification Certificate' by any Gazetted Officer mentioned in the certificate at page 4 of Verification Bill.

o. Women candidates, those women candidates who appear for serving in pursuance to the 'Offer of Appointment' and as a result of which is found to be pregnant or 07 (seven) weeks standing or over shall be declared 'Temporary unfit' and her appointment shall be held in abeyance until the confinement is over, she should be re-examined for fitness certificate six weeks after the date of confinement, subject to the issuance of a medical certificate of fitness from a registered medical practitioner. Those woman candidate who is found to be pregnant or period less than 12 (twelve) weeks standing will be allowed to do but will not undergo BRTC at the time of her joining. She will report back to the unit in time 1 year at training centre.

The appointment will further be subject to:-

His undersigned or a declaration about his/her marital status in accordance with the orders in force regarding appointment under Govt. of India that no person, who has more than one spouse living or who having spouse living married in any state in which such marriage is valid by law at the time of his/her taking place during the life time of such spouse, shall be eligible for appointment, employment, or appointment in the Force. Any person subject to the SSB Act, who contracts or enters into a second marriage during the life time of his/her first spouse shall render him/herself incapable for retention in service and may be separated from his/her service on ground of unsuitability. Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that there are circumstances, disallowing exempt any person from the operation of this rule. Therefore,

In the event of having more than one spouse living, the appointment will be subject to his/her being demobilized from the service concerned if necessary for any specific reason. He/She will be considered by the Government and specific exemption granted therefor.

b) Relative named in nomination letter is required to sign the form of commitment as set out in Appendix I of SSB Rule 2000. In case he/she fails to do so, he/she shall be liable to punishment under SSB Act 2000.

c) Having an oath of allegiance to the Constitution of India or making a written affirmation to that effect on the prescribed form, see Annexure A of SSB Rule 2000.

- d) At the time of joining the post, He/she is required to furnish the following documents:
- a. Original Certificate of SC/ST/BPL or Any Other Indian Community of application.
 - b. Non-Caste Lower Certificate in case of OBC candidates. Specimen Prototype is enclosed.
 - c. Meritacle Certificate issued by the concerned authority not later than the date of Selection.
 - d. Original Educational Certificates.
 - e. Certificate relating to Date of Birth, age relaxation, if any.
 - f. Discharge Certificate /Any.
 - g. Recent passport size colour photograph (10 Nos).
- h) If any case prosecuted against you in any court of law, copy of the orders passed by the court and if the case is still pending against you, copy of complete case documents.
- i. Uniform in your personal belongings (including uniform, respective clothing, accessories like Rs. 400/- to meet your basic requirement for full uniform, Selection Rail purchased - obtaining signature with seal on the "Meritacle Certificate" by any gazetted Officer, w/o interference at any stage), a P.D. (Discharge Rail).
- j. Certificate from the local administrative authorities that (i) Chief Minister/State/Union Territory Governor/Minister or any Officer superior to him in the State/Central Government, regarding neither character and qualifications (as per format enclosed), whom should have been issued before six months prior the date of joining.
- k. He/she is required to state, if he/she is serving or is under obligation to serve another Central Govt. Department, a State Government or Public Sector Undertaking.
- l. He/she is required to submit an undertaking that if any adverse report comes into the knowledge during the course of Meritacle of his/her Character and Antecedents through local administration/Police authorities higher authority may be terminated without assigning any reason.
- m. If any certificate given or information furnished by him/her is found to be false or in name or found to have withheld any important information, neither service and be liable to be terminated along with such other action as prescribed in SSB Act 2000 & SSB Rules. Information of Central Government may deem necessary.


